Terms of Service

RULES

1. Copyright

- Unless explicitly stated otherwise, all artwork is for non-commercial use exclusively.
- Redistribution of the artwork for promotion, merchandise, or resale is prohibited unless stated otherwise.
 - Commercial use may be discussed, and will follow a different payment plan than non-commercial works.
- > Please DO NOT alter any commissioned artwork significantly.

Tracing/recoloring/repurposing the image is prohibited without permission.

- The client may repost artwork on social media or other websites, but the client may not claim ownership/creation of the artwork. Instances of shared artwork must link back to one of these pages:

- I hold the right to share the artwork on my social media and portfolio site, unless requested otherwise by the client.
- Artwork may NOT be used for the following purposes under any circumstances:
 - NFT or Crypto trading
 - AI image generation
 - Explicit / NSFW content

2. Payment

All payments must be processed through PayPal or Zelle. Payment information will be provided at the beginning of the work process, or after a sketch is completed.

- Payment must be provided within 3 days (72 hrs) unless communicated otherwise. If I do not receive a response within the allotted time, the commission will be canceled, and any assets created may be repurposed after.
- Refunds are allowed until the base sketch is completed. After which, a 75% refund is allowed. If any processes past the sketch phase (line, color, shade, etc) are completed, NO refunds may be processed.
- If a refund is requested, the client may not use the artwork unless stated otherwise.
- I reserve the right to cancel a commission at any point, for any reason. If I should choose to do so, the client may request a refund. A full refund is not guaranteed.

3. Communication / WIPs

- > The client must provide an avenue to communicate during the drawing process.
 - The preferred platform of communication is **Discord**, however, the client may request alternative options.
 - The client may contact me on Discord (Firestia#0468), through email (<u>firestiart@gmail.com</u>), or through social media DMs at any point for questions.
- > The client must be prepared to give feedback on WIP work during the creation process.
 - The client should expect to receive a message once I am ready to begin the commission, and another message to confirm the sketch composition before rendering may begin.
 - If the client does not respond within 3 days (72 hrs) of a message, I will put their commission on hold, and reserve the right to cancel at any time. A client on hold may be moved to the bottom of my priority list, and will then wait for higher priority commissions to be completed before resuming progress.
- The client is free to message regarding questions, but is advised not to request updates frequently.
 - I will provide updates as they come. Requesting information will not make the work move any faster.
 - If the client has concerns about deadlines, they may reach out in regards to ensuring priority. It is requested that the client provide any deadlines when

submitting a commission request, as I cannot guarantee my availability for rush work at any given time.

- > I reserve the right to cancel a commission over any communication deemed inappropriate or uncomfortable.
- The estimated wait time for a commission may be 6+ months at any given point. By agreeing to the commission waitlist, the client must be prepared to wait an indefinite amount of time before I am ready to begin their work.
 - It is expected of the client to be patient as I move towards working on their piece, and they must understand that I am not always able to be working consistently.
 - You may check my <u>Trello board</u> at any point to see current waitlist progress.
 - Once payment is completed and a client's commission started, the client can expect between a day and 2 weeks until their work is completed, unless the commission requires an unusual amount of work (ex. Multiple characters / group pieces).

By requesting a commission, the client agrees to have read these rules thoroughly. If any of these rules are broken, the commission may be canceled, and the client blacklisted from further work.
